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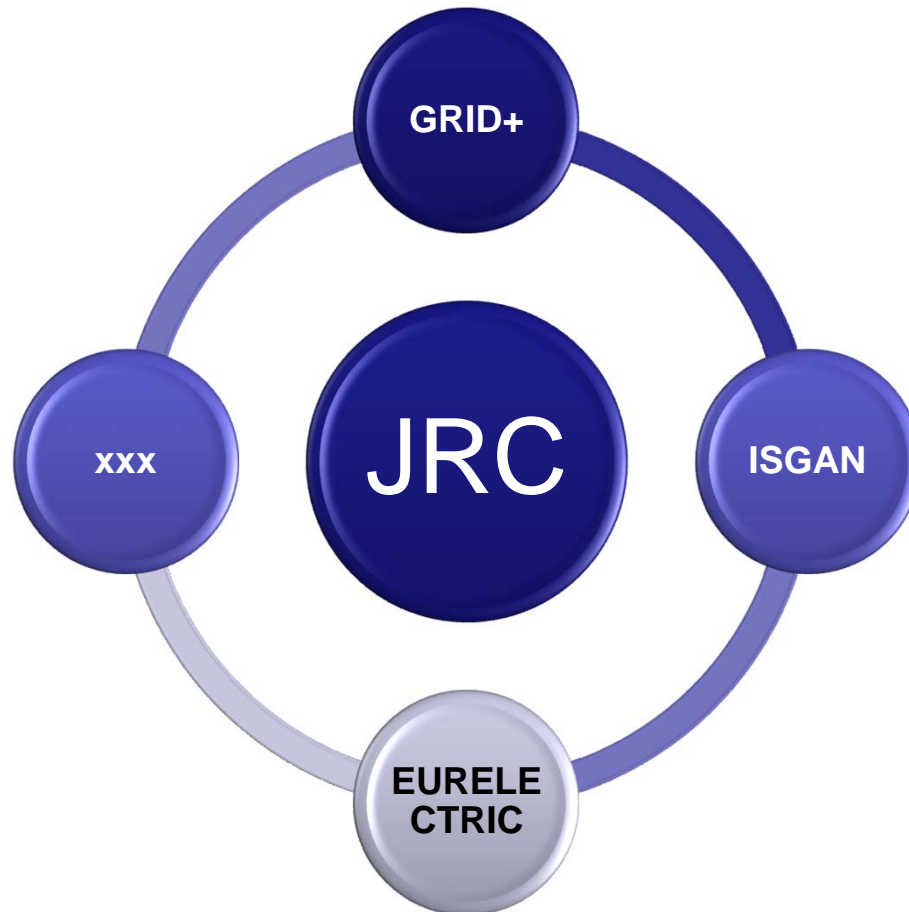


Objectives of mapping



- Understand drivers for the development and deployment of smart grids activities at European and international level
- Interpret activity at the light of the EEGI priorities
- Find out opportunities to leverage existing knowledge and experience and point out necessary activities to complete the knowledge spectrum deemed necessary in the EEGI roadmap.
- Indicate knowledge sharing necessities and international collaboration routes.

Necessary interactions



- A common EU database;
- Careful validation:
 - GRID+
 - ERA-NET
- Continuous maintenance and updating ;
- Open off-line access to data for specific elaboration and visualization;
- Motivation to operators to have their projects listed and correctly classified and highlighted (a role for national representatives);
- **ONE SINGLE VOICE FOR EUROPE**



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS



- Accessibility of non-confidential data to registered users
- Data collected must allow the foreseen post-elaboration:
 - For the specific requirements of GRID+:
 - Allow the extraction of demonstration projects according to EEGI definitions;
 - Allow project clustering according to EEGI scheme;
 - Allow project labelling;
 - Allow elaboration of project results according to knowledge sharing rules defined by EEGI, including KPIs;
 - Allow financing, policy and regulatory lessons learning;
 - Allow elaborations on upscaling and replication.
- DATA COLLECTION TEMPLATE MUST BE ADAPTED TO THE INTEGRAL OF ELABORATION EXIGENCE
