EEGI Team Volunteers wishing to be EEGI Labelling experts should send their request to GRID+ by June 8 2012

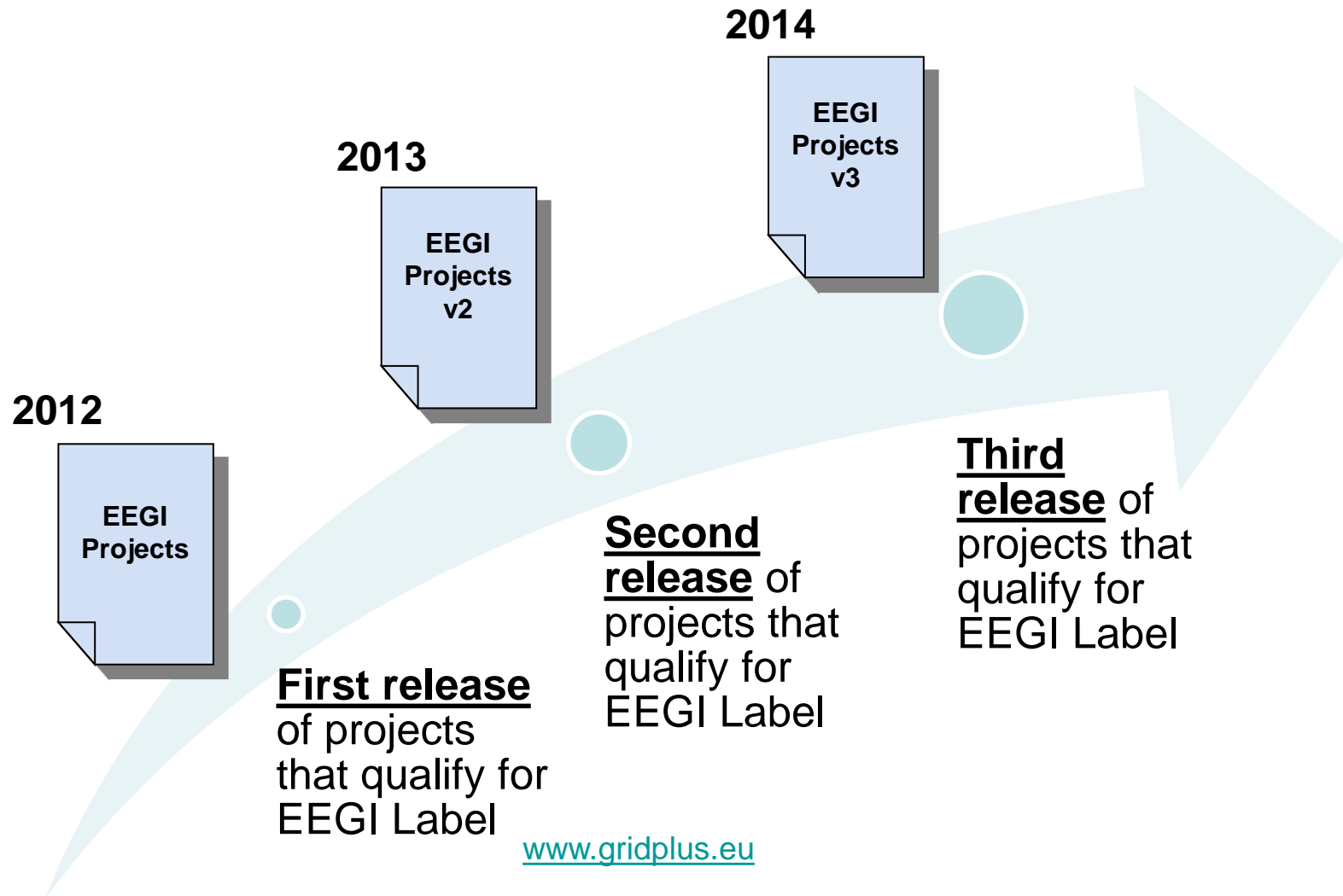


- Deadline for request is **June 8 2012**.
